

Swinging

When working on language, it is important to target all types of words. Using nouns, verbs, adjectives, and pronouns will help your child combine words into phrases and sentences.

LEVEL 1: ONE-WORD PRODUCTIONS

Nouns: swing

Verbs: push, go, stop, spin, help

Adjectives: fast, slow

Pronouns: me, you, I

LEVEL 2: TWO-WORD PRODUCTIONS

push me, go fast, go slow, you push, I go, push fast, push slow, stop me, spin me, spin fast, spin slow, help me

ASKING QUESTIONS

Do you want to go fast or slow?

What do you want?

Who should push?

You stopped! What should we do?



Bubbles

LEVEL 1: ONE-WORD PRODUCTIONS

Nouns: bubbles

Verbs: open, blow, pop, go, turn

Adjectives: big, little

Pronouns: I, you, my, your

LEVEL 2: TWO-WORD PRODUCTIONS

open bubbles, go bubbles, blow bubbles, big bubbles, little bubbles, my bubbles, I blow, you blow, my turn, your turn

ASKING QUESTIONS

What do you want?
Do you want a big bubble
or little bubble?
Whose turn is it?
